








MRO Center

The state-of-the-art hub for aircraft maintenance, repair and overhaul. This is set to become the most advanced MRO centre in the region.


MASTER TIMELINE OF MAJOR INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

IN 2017, MOST INVESTMENTS IN TARGETED INDUSTRIES







Eligible Industries

- 10 targeted industries and related businesses with high technology which would enhance the existing targeted industries
- Service Industries, Tourism Industries, and MICE Industries
- Research and development, required or supportive education for the targeted industries development
- Any other targeted industries that are approved and announced by the EEC Policy Committee

Conduct the businesses within the Promotional Zones





Incentives from other agencies

Tax Incentives

BOI

- Exemption of Corporate Income Tax at the maximum of 13 years (for certain activities) with 50% Tax Reduction for the additional 5 years
- Exemption of import duties on machinery
- Exemption of import duties on raw materials used in (1) production for exports and (2) research & development
- Costs incurred by certain research & development activities can be deducted as expenses (100 300 %)
- Targeted Technological Development Fund according to the Competitiveness Enhancement Act

Ministry of Finance

- Special rate for Personal Income Tax at 17% for foreign workers in the Promotional Zones (including their parents, spouse, and children)
- Special rate for Personal Income Tax at 15% for foreign executives working in the headquarter offices or international trade offices located in the EEC



Incentives from other agencies

Non-Tax Incentives

Land and Real Estate Ownership

- Foreign legal entities are entitled to land ownership for the purpose of business operations in the special economic zone (Promotional Zone).
- Foreign legal entities are entitled to condominium ownership for residence purpose and for business operations in the Promotional Zone.
- Foreign legal entities are entitled to enter into lease / sublease / lease-out contract for land or real estate within the Promotional Zone for no more than 50 years, the contract of which can be renewed for no more than 49 years.

Foreign Entrance and Residence in Thailand

• Foreign experts / executives / specialists including their spouses and dependent persons are allowed to enter the Kingdom of Thailand

Financial Transactions

• Business operators are exempted from the Law on Foreign Currency Exchange Control and are allowed to use foreign currencies in the Promotional Zone

Others

- Business operators in the Promotional Zone are entitled to the same privileges as business operators in the Duty Free Zone / Bonded Warehouse / Free Zone.
- Professional practitioners or applicants are entitled to obtain license, registration, or certificates to practice their professions for business
